Short description of subject	Ethics course covers 1 semester and 30 didactic hours. Lectures are in weekly intervals during whole semester 2 h each and demonstrate the main concepts and problems of the theoretical and practical ethics. Lectures have both systematic and historical character. Detailed description of topics is available in syllabus. The final grade will be given to students on the basis of their participation in classes, as well as their marks from
	the written final test. Students are allowed to have 2 absences which are unaccounted for. In case of multiple absences it will be necessary to pass them orally or writtenly.
