

PRINCIPLES OF SCORING
IN THE PROCEDURES OF RECRUITMENT OF
CANDIDATES TO THE DOCTORAL SCHOOL
OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LIFE SCIENCES IN LUBLIN
IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR/.....

pursuant to § 7 of the resolution no. 56/2019-2020 of the Senate of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin of 3 April 2020 on the conditions and procedures of recruitment to the Doctoral School of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin in the academic year 2020/2021

The procedures of recruitment take into account:

1). Mean grade of first and second cycle studies, or full – time Master’s degree studies (the number of points obtained corresponds to the mean grade)

- A candidate may obtain a maximum of **5 points**
- The mean grade obtained during studies is the arithmetic mean (the sum of all grades divided by the number of all grades).

2). Candidate’s current documented scientific activity

- A candidate’s scientific activity shall be evaluated based on **Annex no. 2**
- A candidate may obtain **0-10 points**
- On the basis of Annex no. 2 filled in by Candidates , Recruitment Committee calculates the sum of points for each Candidate. The Candidate, with the highest number of points shall obtain the maximum value = **10 points**. Points for the remaining candidates shall be calculated based on the mathematical proportion

the highest number (sum) of points = **10 points**

lower number (sum) of points = **x**

- Instructions for the evaluation of scientific activity (Annex no. 2)

1) Authorship or co-authorship of scientific publications	
a) Publications from the register of Journal Citation Reports (JCR)	Points awarded by the Committee = points of MNiSW for the publication (15, 20,25,30, 40, 45.... pkt.)
b) Scored publications - register B	Points awarded by the Committee = points of MNiSW for the publication (8, 10....pkt.)
c) Chapter in the monograph	5 points
d) Monograph	20 points
e) Popular-scientific publication	5 points

3). The result of the interview; presentation of the research topic in English

a) presentation in Polish

- Candidate may obtain **(0-5 points)** for the interview in Polish concerning the presentation of his/her scientific interests, planned research he/she intend to conduct as part of his/her education at the Doctoral School.

The chairperson and members of the Committee representing the disciplines assess individually by awarding points **(0-5 points.)** – the above evaluation grades are allowed (0; 0,5; 1; 1,5; 2 points.....). Points for the candidate's interview are calculated on the basis of the arithmetic mean (the sum of points/the number of assessor).

b) presentation in English

- Candidate may obtain **(0-5 points)** for the interview in Polish concerning the presentation of his/her scientific interests, planned research he/she intend to conduct as part of his/her education at the Doctoral School.

English teachers assess individually by awarding points **(0-5 points.)** – only a score of 0.5 points is allowed. Points for the candidate's interview are calculated on the basis of the arithmetic mean (the sum of points/the number of assessors).

4) Diamond grant winners obtain an additional of 5 points.

The Recruitment Committee determines the ranking of candidates based on the calculation of:

Points in total = points (1point) + points (2 point) + points (3 points) + points (4 point) = the sum of points for the candidate
