AIMS

Academic writing is a integral process of research and generation of scientific knowledge. The research scholars usually lack in the ability to prepare research reports and dissertations in a systematic manner and publish research papers in reputed journals owing lack of adequate training in the research methodology, critical thinking and academic writing skills.

The workshop is designed for young scholars, e.g. Ph.D. students and postdocs who would like to improve their academic writing skills in order to succeed in studies and in career. To explain the key elements and identify the foundation of academic writing; To gain an



appreciation of what quality means in the context of academic writing with creative, meaningful and attractive story; To write clear, well-structured academic texts of some length, with a high degree of grammatical accuracy

and in an appropriate style; To explain the correct way to prepare your figures and advance them with better visual effect.

LECTURER

Dr. Shubiao Wu, Associate Professor in Aarhus University, Denmark. Dr. Wu has dedicated to exploring efficient natural-based solutions for wastewater treatment and approaches promoting nutrients recycling from wastewater to agriculture. He has a great research interest in biogeochemical interactions of various pollutants degradation pathways in wetland and soil systems. Dr. Wu has published >100 peer-reviewed journal articles and about 50% of those in reputed journals with impact factor > 5.0. He received several academic awards on education and technology innovations. He was also awarded Marie Sklodowska-Curie Co-founded fellowship from EU and Humboldt Experienced Researchers Fellowship from Germany. In this workshop, Dr. Wu will share his special expertise on graphics preparation.
