<i>Aim of the course</i>	The aim of the module is to show doctoral students the main research trends undertaken in the country and abroad in the discipline of Agriculture and horticulture and to introduce basic legal, formal, methodological, substantive, and technical issues related to writing a doctoral dissertation and prepare doctoral students for independent analysis of professional literature addressing specific issues related to production of food with increased health-enhancing values. During the seminar, the doctoral student learns relevant procedures of planning and conducting research, interpreting study results, discussing the results against the available scientific literature, and formulating conclusions. An additional aim of the module for the doctoral student is to acquire skills of delivering presentations and a substantive discussion on issues related to the topics addressed in the doctoral school.
<i>Course contents</i>	The doctoral seminar is focused on expanding PhD students' knowledge in the specific scientific discipline and about the principles of compliance with the scientific work law and ethics. Additionally, it is designed to educate and consolidate the skills of preparing and delivering presentations and methods for discussion of the addressed research issues and their importance for agricultural and horticultural sciences. It prepares the doctoral student to formulate the research problem, goal, and hypotheses based on the investigation model and its development. It supports doctoral students in the subsequent stages of compiling their doctoral dissertations.
