





Foreign language assistants in Spain

Polish conversation assistants in Spanish public schools

Description:

Grants aimed at university graduates or university students from the second year of their degree onwards; either Polish or with permanent residence in Poland, to work as English conversation assistants in Spanish public primary or secondary schools.

Target group:

University graduates or university students from the second year of their degree onwards; either Polish or with permanent residence in Poland.

Requirements:

Specific participation requirements for Poland:

a) To have Polish nationality or permanent residence in Poland.

b) To be a university student from the second year of their degree onwards in the current academic year 2020-21

or

to hold a university degree.

c) To have turned 18 years of age before January 1st 2022) and be under 60 years of age on January 1st 2023.

d) To not suffer from an illness or condition that makes it impossible for them to carry out their duties as a language assistant.

e) To have a C1 or C2 level of English. If no official certificate is available, the applicant shall undergo a short oral test in English.

f) To submit a signed letter of motivation.

g) To submit a letter of reference or report, from a teacher or employer, issued not before September 2021. The letter or report must be dated and signed.





h) To have a negative certificate of offences of a sexual nature. This certificate may be required at any stage of the process.

Assessment criteria for the selection of candidates:

a) Academic qualifications related to the fields of education, humanities or science. (Up to 10 points).

b) Training activities in the field of language teaching. (Up to 25 points).

c) Participation in voluntary activities, animation, artistic education, music, dance and drama. (Up to 25 points).

d) Level of Spanish language. (Up to 25 points).

e) Knowledge of other languages. (Up to 5 points).

f) Knowledge of Spanish literature, history and culture (students of the Spanish-Polish Bilingual Courses Programme can attest this by submitting their Spanish Baccalaureate Diploma). (Up to 8 points).

g) Letter of reference from the educational institution awarding the degree. (Up to 2 points).

Endowment:

The language and culture assistants will receive a monthly allowance of 700 euros, as a subsistence and accommodation allowance, for 12 hours a week of collaboration with students. In some cases this allowance may be higher if the number of weekly hours of collaboration is increased.

Duration of the Programme:

1 October 2022 to 31 May 2023. The position may be renewed if both the candidate and the school direction agree.

Deadline for applications:

From 1 February 2022. Until 7 April 2022 at 14:00 (UTC + 1).

Candidates from Poland should only register their application for participation through the Profex application.
