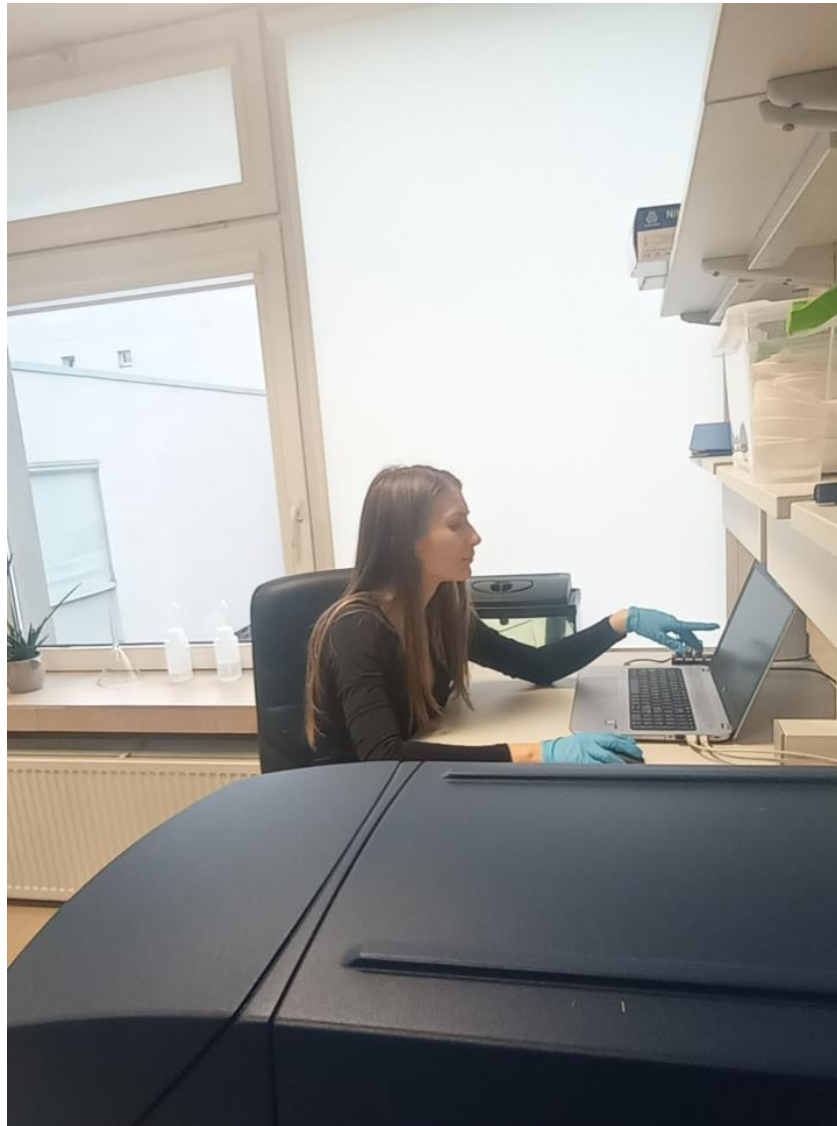

From 7.10.2024 to 5.11.2024 I had the pleasure of doing an internship at LSMU - the Lithuanian University of Health Sciences, in the Department of Animal Nutrition. My supervisor was Prof. Paulius Matusėvičius.

During the internship I had the opportunity to familiarize myself with the analytical methods used in the laboratory specializing in research conducted on milk. Thanks to this, I had the opportunity to observe and support the research team. I familiarized myself with the entire process that the collected milk sample goes through and with the methods used to determine various parameters. I also had the opportunity to quantitatively determine lactoferrin using the HPLC method.
