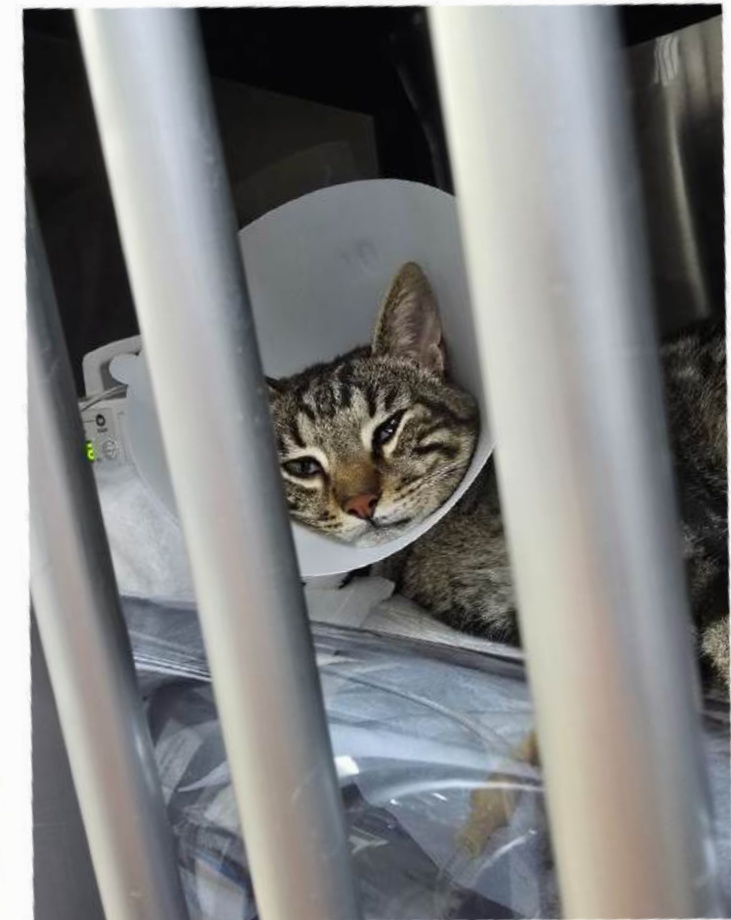
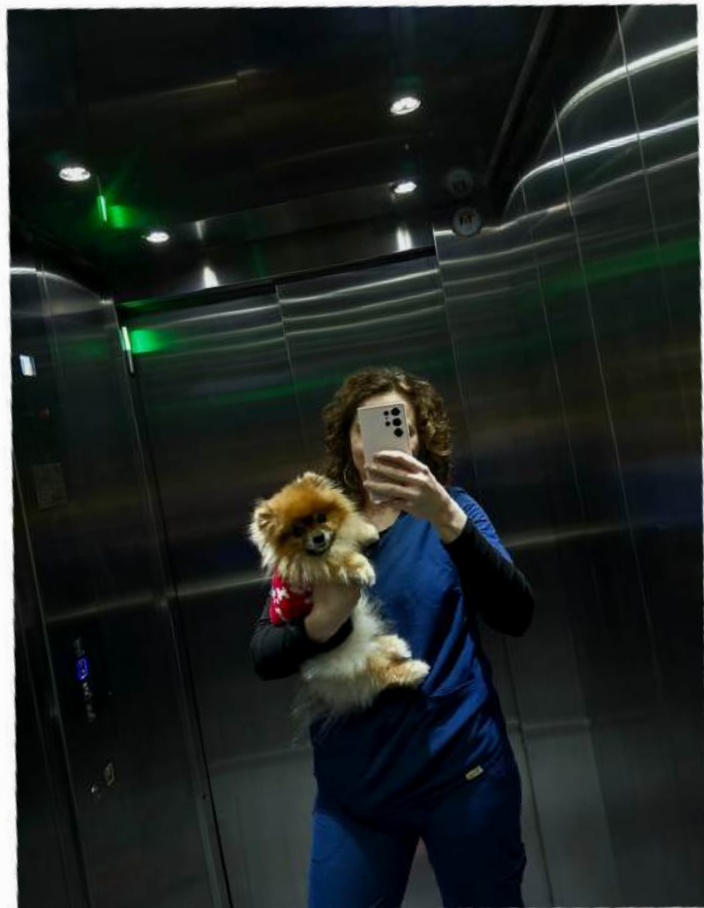
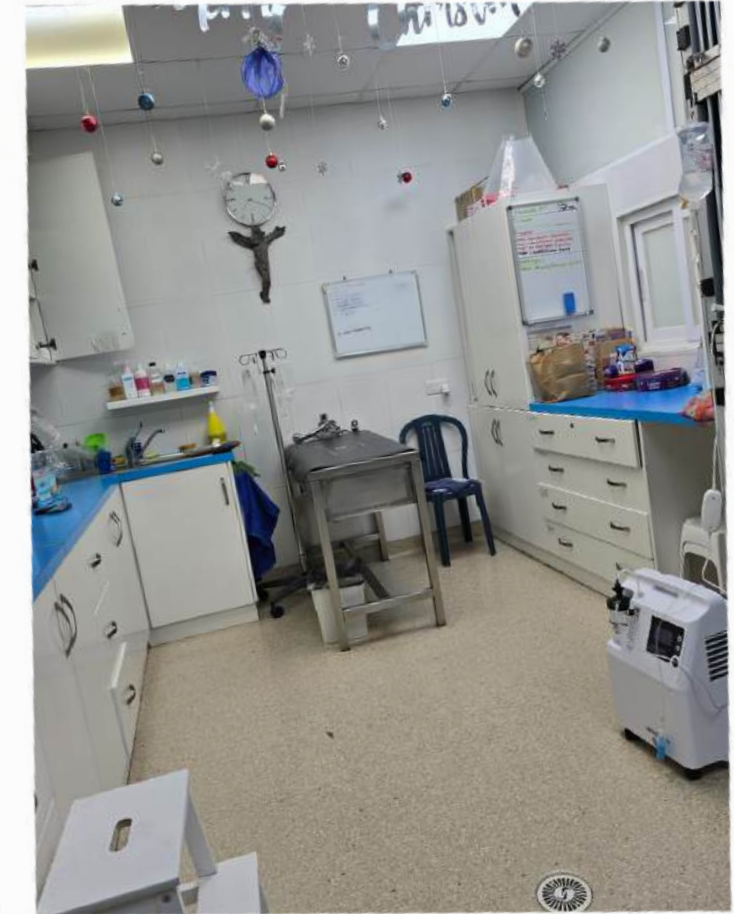
Clinic Overview

- English is widely spoken, which made communication easy and enjoyable.

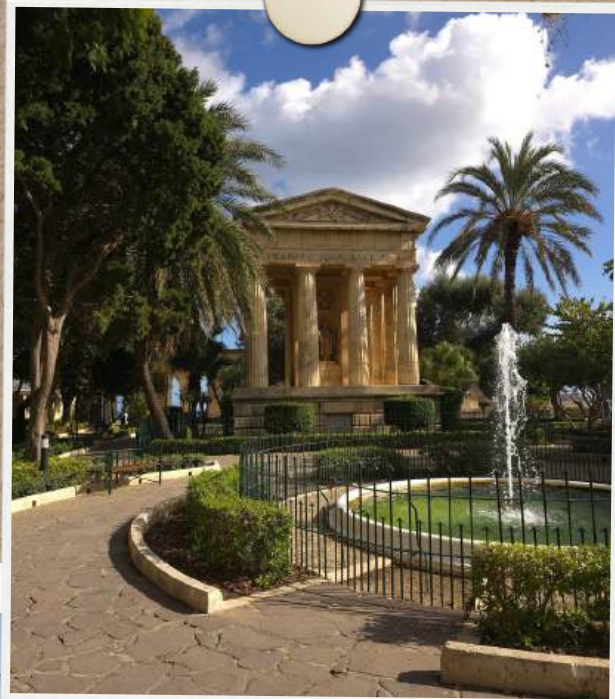




Costs and Tips
