






DISTINCTIVE FEATURES OF THE RESEARCH AT LSMU

LSMU RESEARCH AREAS








INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

152 International students from 14 countries arrived under the Erasmus exchange programme for the Fall semester



- Animal and Human Interaction, master studies, full-time and part-time (1,5/2 years).


