- It is located on the Wild Atlantic Way, which stretches along the Irish coast.


Facilites

Normal day







- TB (Tuberculosis) testing of local cattle herds.
- Elective surgeries; spaying, castration, Dental procedures.
- Routine appointments; vaccinations, health checks, dosing of large animals.
- The clinic is also prepared for emergencies for both large animals and small animals.
 - RTAs, cesarean sections etc.
- There is also a local orthopedic vet that routinely joins the clinic to perform extensive bone surgery including TPLOs and plating bones.
