



We invite **doctoral students and academic staff** to participate in the **PROM – Short-Term Academic Exchange** programme, funded by **NAWA** with resources from the **European Union (FERS)**!

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The aim of the project is to develop the scientific, research, teaching, and social competences of mobility participants, as well as to increase the level of internationalization and the quality of education at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin.

The project includes the implementation of **70 short-term (5, 7, 14, or 30 days) academic mobilities** for **doctoral students and academic staff** from the University of Life Sciences in Lublin, as well as for **doctoral students and academic staff** coming to the University of Life Sciences in Lublin from abroad.

Purpose of departure/arrival (mobility)

The purpose of the mobilities carried out under the **PROM – Short-Term Academic Exchange** project is to acquire or enhance the scientific, research, teaching, and social competences of participants, as well as to develop international cooperation and facilitate the exchange of academic experience.

Mobilities may include, among others:

- ✓ active participation in an international conference (e.g. delivering a presentation, including participation in a poster session),
- ✓ collecting materials for a doctoral thesis or a scientific article,
- ✓ participation in a summer school or winter school,
- ✓ conducting measurements using unique equipment or testing research apparatus,
- ✓ participation in courses, including intensive courses credited as part of the study programme, workshops, professional or industrial internships, and study visits, including those carried out at enterprises,

- ✓ conducting archival or library research.
- ✓ delivering teaching activities,
- ✓ participation in the preparation of an international grant application,
- ✓ as well as hosting doctoral students and academic staff from abroad at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin for the above-mentioned purposes.

Participants organize their mobility independently and obtain confirmation of acceptance from the foreign host institution. **The departure/arrival must be completed no later than 15 September 2026.**

Funding

Project participants are eligible for funding covering: ✓ **a scholarship** based on daily rates, ✓ **a lump sum for travel costs**, ✓ **a lump sum for subsistence and accommodation costs**. Additionally, funding may be granted to cover the costs of conference fees, training, or courses up to the amount of **PLN 2,500**, depending on the availability of funds and justification of the expenses.

Who can participate?

A project participant may be a person with knowledge of English at a minimum **B2 level** who is:

- ✓ a doctoral student of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin,
- ✓ an academic teacher at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin,
- ✓ a doctoral student of a foreign higher education and research institution,
- ✓ an academic teacher employed at a foreign higher education and research institution.

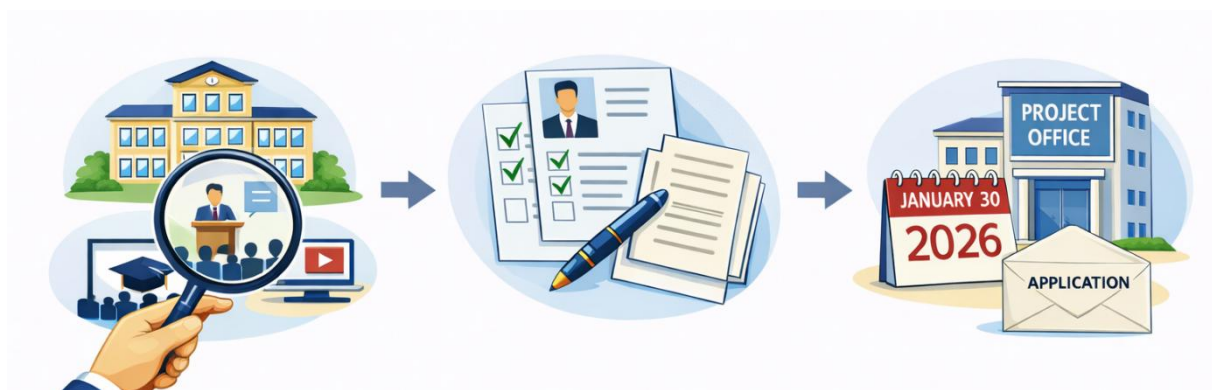
Each person may participate in only one mobility under the project.

Application process

1. Find a Host Institution, Conference, or Course

2. Fill out the application form and prepare the required documents

3. Submit your application to the Project Office



The project "PROM - Short-term academic exchange" is financed by the National Agency for Academic Exchange as part of the project entitled "Short-term academic exchange as a way to improve the quality of education at institutions of higher education and science", no. FERS.01.05-IP.08-0218/23, co-financed by the European Union.

Recruitment will take place from **12 to 30 January 2026**. Applications should be submitted in person or electronically to the PROM Project Office (prom@up.edu.pl), room 455 at the Rectorate of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin, ul. Akademicka 13.

Applications will undergo formal and substantive evaluation. Participation in the project is limited to applicants whose submissions receive a positive evaluation and fall within the available quota of places.

Required documents



The candidate is required to submit the following documents:

- application form,
- statement confirming that the candidate has read and accepted the regulations,
- document confirming English language proficiency at a minimum B2 level,
- document confirming acceptance by the host institution,
- in the case of PhD students – the supervisor's recommendation,
- in the case of international applicants – a document confirming PhD students status or employment.
