**5th International PhD Students' Conference:
Environment-Plant-Animal-Product
at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin,
Poland (ICDSUPL)**

Lublin, February 27th, 2026

Initial arrangements

1. The organizer of 5th International PhD Students' Conference: Environment-Plant-Animal-Product together with the International Workshops at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin, Poland, herein after referred to as the "event", is the Doctoral School of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin.
2. The event will be held on from 22nd to 24th April 2026.
3. First day of the event includes 5th International PhD Students' Conference: Environment-Plant-Animal-Product and will be held in buildings of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin in hybrid form.
4. Second and third days of the event includes The International Workshops supported by the STER NAWA project "Actions towards the internationalization of the Doctoral School of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin (ICDSUPL)" and will be held in the Lublin Province in stationary form.
5. Registration of participants and sending abstracts by March 31th, 2026.

Rules of participation

1. The participants of the event are PhD students of doctoral schools, PhD students of universities, research and scientific institutes, young researchers as well as graduates of studies.
2. One event participant (registered) may send one abstract as part of the event fee, which will be presented as an oral or poster presentation. If more than one abstract is to be published, the participant is obliged to increase the fee for subsequent abstracts.
3. The participant (registered) will receive a certificate of active participation in the event with an indication of the presentation form (oral or poster presentation).

Conditions for submitting participation and abstracts

1. The condition for registering for participation in the event is the correct completion of the registration form available on the website [Conference](#).
2. Application for participation is the consent to the processing of personal data for the purposes necessary to conduct the event and consent to the publication of the abstract by the University

of Life Sciences in Lublin on the basis of Creative Commons recognition of authorship 4.0 international (CC BY 4.0). Personal data will not be transferred to any other data administrator.

3. The abstract should only be submitted in electronic form available on the website [Conference](#).
4. It will be possible to attach an abstract until March 31th, 2026, until 12:00 am.
5. Each participant is required to read the GDPR regulations set out in these regulations. Registration of participation in the event is a simultaneous consent to the processing of personal data by the University of Life Sciences in Lublin.

Organization and course of the event

1. The event will include sessions in English (oral presentations and posters) and workshops conducted in English.
2. Scientific research presented at the first day of the event – Conference – covers the following thematic blocks: Food Quality; Animal Sciences; Plant Sciences; Environment; Technology; Basic Sciences and Health Sciences. A event participant by sending a conference abstract authorizes the organizer to place it on the abstract platform as open access. Conference abstracts will be given a DOI number.
3. The duration of oral presentations is up to 10 minutes. Posters will be presented during coffee breaks in the form of a multimedia presentation for on-line participants and the printed form for stationary participants.
4. Rules for the preparation of the abstract:
 - a) title
 - b) affiliation: authors' names and surnames, department/institute, university, street, zip code, city, country, e-mail address
 - c) the content of the abstract: the content of the abstract should include: introduction, hypothesis and aim of the study, material and methods, results, conclusions. The text (including title, affiliations and keywords) should not exceed one A4 page (font size 11 pts, 25 mm margins, line spacing 1.15). Latin names should be written in italics. All abbreviations, other than those commonly used, must be explained in their first occurrence. The abstract should not be structured, and the text should not contain citations, as it is not possible to include a reference list. Do not include graphic elements

in the abstract. British English or American English may be used, but consistently throughout the text.

d) The source of funding should be included if applicable.

5. Rules for the preparation and presentation of the poster:

The poster should contain: name and surname of the author/authors, title, name of the university, aim of the study, material and methods, results, conclusions.

For on-line participants the poster in pdf format should be sent by March 31, 2026 to conference.doctoral@up.edu.pl. The presentation of the poster will take place only in the multimedia form. For stationary participants the poster should be printed vertically in A1 format. The organizer has the right to refuse to accept an abstract or poster unprepared in accordance with the editorial requirements.

6. The organizer has the right to refuse to accept the proposed topic of the abstract if it does not fit into the designated thematic blocks.

7. By April 10th, 2026 the organizer will publish the event schedule on the event website, but has the right to make changes to it, even on the day of the event.

8. The organizer is not responsible for technical or organizational problems resulting from reasons beyond his control.

9. The participant undertakes to comply with the regulations and the organizational and technical instructions of the organizer.

Event participation cost

1. The costs of participation in the event (22nd – 24th April 2026) for PhD students of the Doctoral School of University of Life Sciences in Lublin is covered by the Doctoral School Office.

2. The basic fee for active participation during the first day of the event (22nd April 2026) for both stationary is 73 Euro (or 300 PLN) and includes the participation in the Conference; one abstract with DOI publication; coffee break and lunch for stationary participants. On-line participation costs 35 Euro (or 145 PLN).

3. The fee for the participation in the entire event (22nd – 24th April 2026) is 420 Euro (1750 PLN). The fee includes: participation in the Conference and International workshops; one abstract with DOI publication; accommodation; coffee breaks and lunches during the event; gala dinner;

4. Additional fee for transport from and to Lublin is 14 Euro (or 60 PLN).
5. If you want to publish more than one abstract, the cost of each subsequent abstract is 120 PLN or 25 Euro

4. Failure to make the payment within the indicated period means resignation from participation.
5. Invoices will be issued for all registered participation and sent to the e-mail address provided by the participant.
6. The event fee is non-refundable.

The regulations were developed by the event organizer and are valid from January 22th, 2026.

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

(becoming acquainted with the Information Clause is obligatory)

In accordance with Art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (GDPR) the University of Life Sciences in Lublin states that:

Your personal data will be processed due to your participation in the "3rd International PhD Students' Conference: Environment-Plant-Animal-Product together with the International Workshops at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin, Poland (ICDSUPL)" and will be used for organizational purposes, statutory, archival, statistical.
4. The legal basis for the processing of your data is Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. b GDPR - processing is necessary to participate in the 5th International PhD Students' Conference: Environment-Plant-Animal-Product at the University of Life Sciences in Lublin, Poland (ICDSUPL) and pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. e GDPR, in connection with the implementation of the tasks and mission of the university in the field of education, scientific activity, as well as participation in social development and the creation of an economy based on innovation. In the case of people

participating in the event in a stationary mode and people taking participation in the event in a remote mode (on-line) with an enabled webcam. Your personal data (image) will be processed on the basis of art. 6 sec. 1 lit. a, i.e. by expressing consent in the form of an unequivocal confirming action, which is understood as personal participation at the event venue or the inclusion of a webcam in the case of remote participation. Your image may be disseminated in connection with the live broadcast of the event on Internet TV , the Internet and on the YouTube channel, and it may be recorded in the form of photos, videos and recordings , and may be disseminated in connection with the event by publishing materials in the media, on the event website and on the event profiles in social networks.

5. Providing data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected.
6. Your data shall be stored for the period necessary to perform the tasks and the period resulting from legal provisions.
7. Your data shall only be disclosed to persons authorized by the University.
8. Your data shall be disclosed only to entities based on data processing agreements or to entities based on legal provisions.
9. Your data, to the extent that it constitutes public information, shall also be disclosed to any interested party who applies to the University for disclosure of public information.
10. You have the right to access your data.
11. You have the right to the erasure of your data or to restrict processing of the data in the cases justified by the circumstances indicated in Art. 17, 18 and 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016.
12. In the cases where the basis for processing the data is your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent any time.
13. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection in the case that it is justified and your personal data is processed by the Controller contrary to the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016.
14. The scope of your data processed by the University may result from a legal provision or may be voluntary but necessary for the performance of tasks.
